

PRESS RELEASE N° *1171* C/CAB/MINEDUB

As part of the implementation of the third contractualization programme for Primary and Nursery School Teachers in the Ministry of Basic Education, the Government with the support of the World Bank, is launching the sixth phase of recruitment of **three thousand (3,000) teachers** for the **2024 session**, to teach in Government Primary Schools in Cameroon.

This recruitment will be based on a regional selection test, based on the **needs of schools** requiring teachers (job posting). To this end, the Minister of Basic Education has the honour to inform the educational community that the quotas to be recruited under this test are as follows:

The above-mentioned test will take place **on Saturday 23 November 2024** in the capital cities of the country's ten (10) regions, according to the following programme:

Candidates for recruitment must meet the following conditions:

- Be of Cameroonian nationality, regardless of gender;
- holders of a CAPIEMP obtained no later than the 2019 session;
- Not older than forty (40) years of age by 31 December 2024;
- undertake to serve for at least five (05) years in the post to which they are assigned;
- Choose a school from the list of needy schools published for the occasion.

The selection test is open to holders of the 2019 CAPIEMP and to all holders of previous CAPIEMPs, whether or not they have taken part in previous phases of this third recruitment programme. Interested candidates are asked to submit an application file, with the following details:

- (1) A stamped application addressed to the MINISTER OF BASIC EDUCATION;
- (2) Two passport photos (4X4 format);
- (3) A certified copy of birth certificate (not less than 03 months old);
- (4) Two certified copies of the CAPIEMP or Teacher's Grade One Certificate;
- (5) An unstamped photocopy of the professional diploma;
- (6) A certified photocopy of the National Identity Card;
- (7) Non conviction n°3 from the court (less than 03 months old);
- (8) A medical examination report;
- (9) A civil status information sheet;
- (10) A candidate identification form, a model of which can be obtained from each Regional Delegation of the Ministry of Basic Education;
- (11) An undertaking on honour to serve in the same post for 05 years;
- (12) A letter of motivation specifying the needy school chosen;
- (13) A certified copy of the marriage certificate (if applicable);
- (14) A certificate of residence in the region applied for;
- (15) An A4 envelope, stamped with the applicant's address.

Completed applications shall be deposited, against a receipt, at the Regional Delegations for Basic Education, only at examination centres for each region, by **25 October 2024**.

Any incomplete application that does not meet the conditions listed above, especially those involving the choice of a school on the list of schools in need, or that is received late, will be rejected;

It should be noted that the files of candidates not selected at the end of the fifth phase of this recruitment (2023 session) will be sent to the various Regional Delegations of the Ministry of Basic Education, where they may be collected by those concerned, in accordance with local arrangements.

No single application will be received by the Ministry of Basic Education.
